STANFORD SWIMMERS DEFEAT COLORADO UNIVERSITY, 44-14  
TWO FORMER OLYMPIC SWIMMING STARS AND PACIFIC COAST TEAMMATES GIVE  
BRILLIANT EXHIBITION IN C.U. POOL

Mermen from Leland Stanford University defeated the University of Colorado swimmers, 44 to 14, before a small number of spectators in the University pool Wednesday afternoon.

Stanford won first place in every event and established three new pool records - in the 200 yard swim, the 150 yard backstroke and the 200 yard four man relay.
